## World Immunization Week

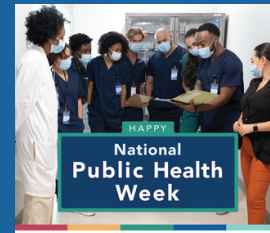
