Course Description:

This is a FREE one day advanced continuing education program on sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and HIV prevention geared towards clinical providers. Leaders in public health, STI, and HIV prevention will discuss trending topics of local and national importance, including STI/HIV epidemiology; pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) disparities and implementation; and sexually-transmitted Zika virus infection.

Objectives:

At the end of this conference, clinicians will be able to:

- Describe STI epidemiology specific to the Midwestern US and the Chicagoland area.
- Identify strategies for PrEP implementation in the Midwestern US.
- Recognize the ways in which Zika virus may be transmitted through sexual contact.
- Discuss disparities in STI and HIV prevention which affect minority and disadvantaged populations.
- Define national focus areas and priorities for STI and HIV prevention.
