VACCINE TEMPERATURE MONITORING CLOUD (VTMC)

Has your data logger previously been recording temperatures?

YES: Sync the data logger and extract all the temperatures on the device (pg. 3).

NO: If you have a new device, you can proceed to the device configuration section (pg. 4).

The Download

Download the DDL to test the connection:

1. Connect the USB Interface cradle to the computer: (If it is not already connected)




2. Insert recorder into cradle:

Data is automatically downloaded and saved.


You will see this animation:


3. Click OK when you are notified that the recorder has been reconfigured:




