TB cases reported in 2016

9,272 cases of TB were reported in the U.S. in 2016.

#### The TB case rate is:

per 100,000 people

The national average is 2.9 per 100,000 people.

# TB IS PREVENTABLE & CURABLE.



TB is spread through the air from one person to another.

### **Symptoms of TB disease include:**

- Cough lasting longer than 3 weeks
- **>** Chest pain
- Weakness
- Night sweats
- Chills
- Weight loss > Fever

## A typical TB case requires:



#### PLUS

- X-rays
- Lab tests
- Follow-up & testing of contacts
