COVID-19 Vaccine Updates for VFC Providers

As you have likely heard, the FDA may grant Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for the first COVID-19 vaccine in mid-December. Since Outpatient and FQHC Healthcare Providers fall within the category of initial healthcare providers to be vaccinated, we are writing to you as to obtain planning information for the city of Chicago. Among healthcare personnel at your clinic, priority will be given to healthcare professionals who are working directly with COVID-19 patients. Any Outpatient Clinic or FQHC outside the city limits fall under the planning scenarios of IDPH which, in principle, is the same process, but through a different jurisdictional authority.

The survey result will allow CDPH to plan for the amount of vaccine that will be needed for Outpatient Centers and FQHCs. We anticipate that you will have additional questions, and they can be directed to our Immunization Team at COVID19Vaccine@cityofchicago.org.

National Influenza Vaccination Week December 6-12, 2020

Chicago VFC Holiday Shipping Schedule



All VFC vaccine orders need to be submitted by **December 11**th, **2020** in order to ship before the holiday shipping shutdown. All orders submitted must have temperature logs submitted and be clear of inventory issues in order to be processed promptly.

Orders that are received after December 11th, have temperature log or inventory issues will ship when CDC resumes regular vaccine shipping the week of January 4th. This includes order for influenza (please send those requests to chicagovfc@cityofchicago.org).
