2020-21 Seasonal Influenza Vaccines are Available! Pre-book here:

A few things to remember:

- Pre-book amount should be requested by **doses** in multiples of 10; if you want 50 doses, please enter **50**, not 5.
- Once available, flu doses will start arriving in your offices. You may not receive your entire order at the same time. We will continue to distribute doses until we have sent your entire pre-book request.
- There is a limited supply of certain influenza vaccine products. If providers request more than what is available, VFC will reach out to your office to redistribute your order with available vaccine.

Providers may choose from the 8 formulations listed below:

All formulations are Quadrivalent Influenza Vaccines (QIV)*

- •Fluzone 0.25 mL pre-filled syringes, preservative free (6-35 months)
- •Fluzone 0.5 mL single dose vials, preservative free (6 months-18 years)
- •Fluzone 0.5 mL single dose syringes, preservative free (6 months-18 yrs.)
- •Fluarix 0.5 mL pre-filled syringes, preservative free (6 months-18 years)
- •Flulaval 0.5 mL pre-filled syringes, preservative free (6 months-18 years)
- •Fluzone 0.5 mL multidose vials (6 months-18 years)
- •Flumist 2 mL pre-filled sprayer, preservative free (2-18 years)
- •Flucelvax 0.5 mL single dose syringe, preservative free (4-18 years)
 - *QIV contains 4 strains of the influenza virus: two influenza A strains and two influenza B strains
