# COVID-19 Vaccine Updates: 3rd Doses, Pfizer FDA Approval

#### **3rd Doses**

- On 9/17, the FDA VRBPAC committee recommended to FDA that a booster should be given at least 6 months after 2nd dose to individuals 65+, 18+ in long-term care, and aged 50-64 years with underlying medical conditions that place them at high risk of severe illness with COVID-19.
- On 9/24, CDC Director Rochelle P. Walensky, M.D., M.P.H., endorsed the CDC Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices' (ACIP) recommendation for a booster shot of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine in certain populations and also recommended a booster dose for those in high risk occupational and institutional settings.
- Currently, there are no advisories on J&J or Moderna booster doses, though FDA with discuss this at two meetings on 10/14 and 10/15

#### **FDA Decisions on Pfizer Vaccine**

FDA approved Pfizer-BioNTech's "COMIRNATY"
 COVID-19 vaccine and adopted it into childhood and



adult vaccination schedule for individuals 16+

- Providers can still administer the series to adolescents 12-15 years old under the FDA emergency use authorization (EUA)
- Continue to use the EUA fact sheet in place of the VIS until further notice
- FDA will be meeting on 10/26 to discuss EUA authorization of Pfizer vaccine for ages 5-11 years. There will be a different formulation distributed for this purpose and we will keep providers updated as we hear about ACIP approval and timing of deliveries.
