### **HOW TO WATCH**

### **HOW TO EARN CME/CE CREDIT AFTER WATCHING**

At the end of June, ICAAP staff will send webinar attendees an email with the link to complete the evaluation. Once you complete the evaluation you will receive your CME/CE certificate within one week by email.

Each attendee is required to complete an evaluation in order to receive a CME/CE certificate. This means ONE evaluation per attendee, regardless of if the presentation was watched together.

Participants who watch the entire presentation and successfully complete the evaluation are eligible for 2.5 CME/CE credits.
